

Inconvenience on Provinciebaan (N229) in Rotselaar

Full closure of Dijle bridge from 25 September 2023

The Roads and Traffic Agency will close the Provinciebaan between the Dijle bridge and the intersection with the Haachtsesteenweg on the night of 24 to 25 September. All water, gas, telecom and electricity pipes near the bridge will be relocated and renewed until mid-November 2023. The Roads and Traffic will start demolishing and reconstructing the 70-year-old Dijle bridge on the provincial road.

In collaboration with Aquafin, we are also tackling the sewers between the Dijle bridge and the Haachtsesteenweg (N21), renewing the road there and laying 2m-wide cycle paths. 2m wide cycle paths. According to the current planning, the works will last until the summer of 2024.

What inconvenience will be there

- La Provinciebaan sera complètement fermée des deux côtés entre la Haachtsesteenweg (N21) et le pont de Dijle.
- As a result, all road users will experience inconvenience during the works.



Pedestrians and cyclists

- Pedestrians can walk past the site zone. Only not across the Dijle Bridge, when the concrete of the new bridge needs to harden or during the works on the cycle path and verges.
- Cyclists can no longer use the Provincial Road. Follow the convenient cycle diversions via the towpath along Demerdijk, Meanderpad, Vakenstraat, Terheidelaan, Torenhoflaan, Torenstraat and Provinciebaan.



Local traffic

Local traffic will follow a diversion in both directions via Haachtsesteenweg/Werchtersesteenweg (N21), Wijgmaalsesteenweg/Wakkerzeelsebaan along the Vaart, Colonel Begaultlaan under the Wilsele viaduct, Aarschotsesteenweg (N19) and the roundabout in Rotselaar towards Stationsstraat and Provinciebaan.



Through and heavy traffic

- Through and heavy traffic are strongly advised to avoid the Rotselaar area and the local road network.
- Those who do need to be in the area follow a diversion in both directions via the Haachtsesteenweg/Werchtersesteenweg (N21), Leuvensesteenweg/Mechelsesteenweg (N26), the E314 exit Holsbeek (No 21) Steenweg op Holsbeek (N229) and the roundabout in Rotselaar towards Stationsstraat and Provinciebaan.



Public transport

- Bus lines 333, 433, 500, 512 and 513 of De Lijn will follow a diversion during the works. Certain stops will not be served, but there will be replacement stops. Don't be taken by surprise. Consult the info at the bus stop, plan your route via delijn.be/routeplanner or contact De Lijn on 070 220 200 (€0.30/minute).



Although we are trying to minimise disruption as much as possible try to minimise disruption, traffic may experience significant delays. The agency therefore asks road users to give due consideration to this when planning their journeys.

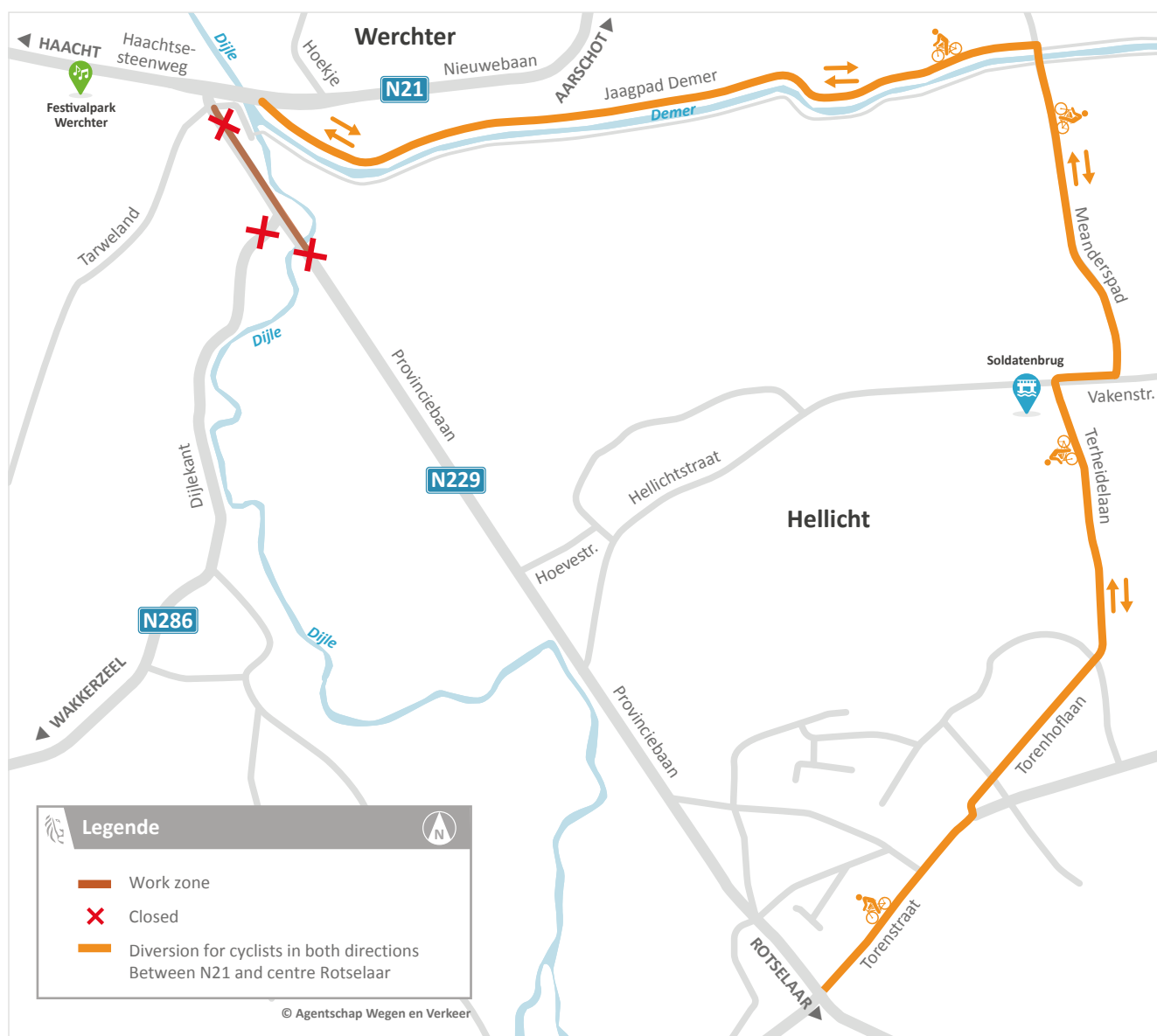

Roadworks Nieuwebaan
To bundle the disruption to the surrounding area, the the municipality of Rotselaar simultaneously with the works on the Dijle bridge, the Nieuwebaan. The Nieuwebaan will have a separate sewer system, a new layer of asphalt layer of asphalt and a separate, two-way bike path 2.50 metres wide. Barring bad weather or technical problems, the works will start in autumn 2023.
